Please Note: The scout will need to bring their personal equipment and should be encouraged to find out for themselves from handbooks what is necessary. It is essential that rucksacks and bags are packed *by the scout* who will not have parental hands to re-pack the kit at the end of the camp.

- Tea-towel
- Towel
- Torch and spare batteries
- Personal first aid kit
- Personal wash kit
- Handkerchiefs
- Day sack and plastic drinks container
- Any medication required (See note below)

Please use a rucksack or other bag which can be carried on your back. Suitcases in particular are not suitable for use in tents.

Medication: If you are likely to require any medication (for example if you sometimes suffer from headaches), please bring it with you to camp. The leaders are willing to store medicine for you if required.

Note: The medical profession takes the view that the parent's consent to medical treatment cannot be delegated. This view is explicit in the Children Act 1989. Thus medical consent forms have no legal status and a doctor/nurse insisting on the consent of a parent to a particular treatment has the right to do so. For this reason we do not recommend that Leaders insist on parents signing the statement above. However, it can be a comfort to medical staff to have general consent in advance from parents or to have a Leader on hand able to sign forms required by medical authorities.
